WHAT IS EBSA?

Emotional Based School Avoidance (EBSA) is a broad umbrella term used to describe a group of children and young people who struggle to engage with and/or attend a school setting due to emotional and systemic factors. This often leads to prolonged absences, difficulty to attend school and/or remain in lessons for an entire day.



We recognise EBSA is caused by a complex number of factors linked to child, family context and school factors.



OUR TIERED INTERVENTIONS

TIER 1 & 2: Identified in school setting. Support for student, family, and school.

TIER 3 (THE COMPASS CENTRE): Students attend The Compass Centre for a period of time with the aim to be supported back into their mainstream school.



We recognise EBSA is caused by a complex number of factors linked to child, context.

In Luton, we recognise EBSA to include both engagement with learning and education as a whole.
