At Key Stage 3, students enjoy a progressive curriculum that develops thematically, designed around key text forms and types of writing. In any given year, pupils are exposed to novels, short stories, plays, poetry, non-fiction and media texts. At Key Stage 4, students follow the AQA GCSE English Language specification and the AQA GCSE English Literature specification.

At Key Stage 5, we currently offer GCE A level AQA English Language and Literature and GCE/A level EDUQAS Film Studies. Our Sixth Form is continually expanding, and as it does, we look to expand our offer in all subjects at Key Stage 5.
