Purpose of the Job:

To provide support to teaching staff to ensure the smooth running of the Art and Design Technology Departments.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Support for the Art and Design Technology Departments

- Ensure an efficient service is provided for the Art and Technology Departments, according to needs and priorities determined by the Head of Technology.
- Ensure that all equipment and machinery is adequately maintained and serviced regularly in order to support delivery of the curriculum.
- Ensure that adequate stock levels of materials and equipment are maintained.
- To undertake appropriate checking, cleaning and required interim testing of all equipment and machinery and to ensure that adequate records and check sheets are completed to evidence each process.
- Prepare materials and equipment for use by students during practical lessons, throughout the faculty.
- Assist with the preparation of teaching resources.
- Ensure that specialist teaching areas are cleared after use and all equipment is cleaned as necessary and put away.
- To be an active member of the Technology Faculty, keeping up-to-date with developments.
- To provide support to staff and students in art and technology lessons.

2. Support for the school

- Develop and maintain effective working relationships with staff and students.
- Contribute to the maintenance of a safe and healthy environment.
- Provide support for school events, e.g. school plays, concerts, etc.
