The Role:

To carry out the professional duties of a Key Stage 2 teacher, as detailed in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document as issued by the DfE.

Main Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be responsible for (but not limited to) the following:

- Follow clear curriculum guidelines to ensure effective teaching objectives and determining how they will be taught and assessed.
- Deliver high quality teaching, which challenges pupils and ensures high levels of interest and good pupil progress.
- Deliver fully inclusive practices, identifying and meeting the needs of all pupils.
- Provide clear structures for lessons, maintaining pace, motivation and challenge.
- Maintain discipline in accordance with the school's procedures and encouraging good practice with regard to punctuality, behaviour and standards of work.
- Select appropriate learning resources.
- Ensure pupils acquire and consolidate knowledge, skills and understanding in line with the requirements of the national curriculum.
- Evaluate own teaching critically to improve effectiveness.
- Ensure the effective and efficient deployment of support staff.
- Assess how well learning objectives have been achieved and use them to improve specific aspects of teaching.
- Mark and monitor pupils' work and set appropriate targets for progress, building upon prior attainment.
- Keep records to evidence pupil progress and inform future planning.
- Prepare and present informative reports to parents.
- Work collaboratively alongside a job share partner to ensure consistency and high standards of teaching and learning for all children.

Wider Responsibilities:

- Be aware of and support difference, ensuring that pupils have equality of access to opportunities to learn and develop.
- Be aware of and comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, health, safety and security, confidentiality and data protection; and report all concerns to an appropriate person.
- To address personal targets as identified within the Performance Management cycle / ECT training.
- To participate in further training and professional development as appropriate, and use the outcomes to impact positively upon the teaching and learning of pupils, including appropriate safeguarding training relevant to the role.
- To work as part of a professional team.
- To implement the aims, policies and stated ethos of the school.
