

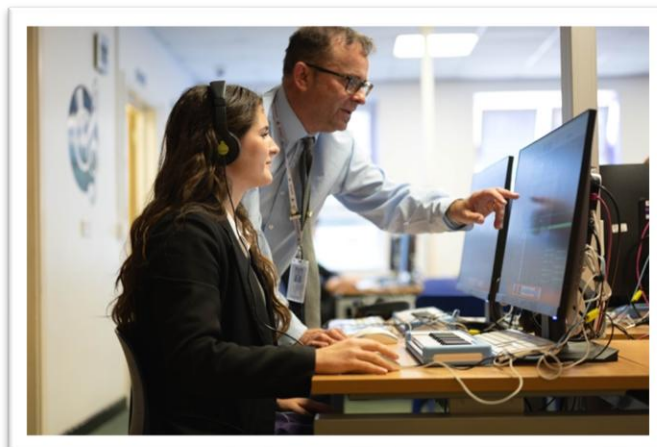

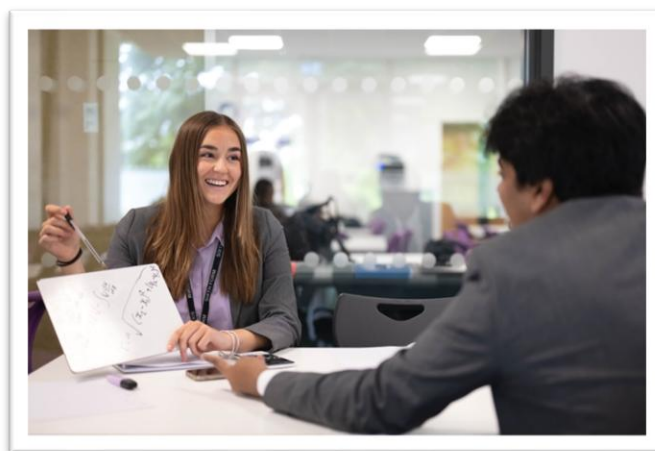
Our dedicated staff work collaboratively to ensure that all students, regardless of their background or abilities, have access to the full curriculum and the support they need to succeed.
