About the Role



As a Non-residential Houseparent, you will form part of the team of staff responsible for providing pastoral care to our boarding students, and the key function is to assist the Residential Houseparents with their evening duties.

Main areas of responsibility

- Help resident staff with afternoon tea for the Boarders
- Supervise prep sessions
- Attend supper with the Boarders
- Support bedtime routines
- Assist resident staff with any evening duties required

You will be assisted by resident staff working to ensure that the staff operate as a team and that their energies and skills are used in the best interests of all boarders resident in the House. Appropriate professional appearance and dress is required at all times, to suit the needs of the role.
