An exciting opportunity for an enthusiastic specialist Saxophone peripatetic instrumental teacher to join our busy and successful Music department. We are looking to appoint a peripatetic Saxophone Teacher who can teach and prepare students for Jazz and Classical exams up to and beyond Grade 8 standard; the ability to accompany and teach Jazz piano would also be an advantage. We currently have 9 students who have weekly individual half-hour lessons. Ideally, applicants should have experience in delivering one-to-one lessons to students of different ages and abilities, including being comfortable with teaching beginners. A willingness to run our established Jazz Workshop and co-curricular Saxophone groups would also be welcomed, and the successful candidate would be expected to contribute to the active musical life of the school.
