



Midday Supervisory Assistant – Person Specification

Qualifications and Experience

- Desirable: Previous experience working with children in a school or childcare setting.
- Basic knowledge of health and safety practices.
- First Aid qualification (desirable but not essential; training may be provided).

Knowledge and Skills

- Ability to supervise and manage groups of children effectively during lunch and playtimes.
- Good communication skills to interact positively with pupils, staff, and parents.
- Ability to observe and monitor children's behaviour and wellbeing, reporting concerns appropriately.
- Competent in maintaining a safe and clean environment.
- Ability to organise and manage resources and equipment efficiently.
- Basic first aid skills or willingness to undertake training.
- Ability to manage minor incidents calmly and effectively.
- Ability to encourage positive behaviour and support the school's behaviour policy.
- Ability to support and promote healthy eating and wellbeing initiatives.
- Understanding of safeguarding procedures and the importance of child protection.
- Awareness of health and safety requirements in a school environment.
- Knowledge of the school's behaviour policy and ability to apply it consistently.



Personal Qualities

- Patient, approachable, and friendly manner.
- Reliable and punctual with a responsible attitude.
- Ability to work as part of a team and follow instructions from senior staff.
- Sensitivity to the needs of children, including those with medical or dietary requirements.
- Commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children.
- Awareness of confidentiality and discretion in handling sensitive information.
- Enthusiastic about encouraging play and positive social interactions among pupils.
