Dear Parents and Carers,

I am incredibly pleased to share with you the final Ofsted report following our recent inspection.

The inspectors have concluded that the school has a clean bill of health and is providing everything that a child needs in order to thrive, be happy, and to succeed.

During their verbal feedback, inspectors were clear that our school has so much to feel proud of and that the vast majority of our students are a genuine credit to the school. This is something we see every day, and it was wonderful to hear it so strongly affirmed.

As you will appreciate, the language used within Ofsted reports can feel rather sterile and tightly bound by the constraints of formal report-writing. However, beneath this measured wording lies a reflection of what we already know about our school and what we continue to work on with purpose and determination. The report affirms our shared understanding of our strengths and the direction in which we are moving.

I would also like to highlight that the current 'Expected Standard' judgement represents a significantly stronger position than the previous 'Good' category, as outlined in Ofsted's own guidance and information materials. I am confident that we are now in a much stronger place than at the time of our 'Good' outcome four years ago. This is evident in the quality of teaching, the rigour of school monitoring and improvement processes, the breadth and ambition of our enrichment curriculum, and the wide range of extra-curricular activities and opportunities available to students. This strength is further reflected in the continued positive progress towards strong academic outcomes, particularly at Key Stage 4 and in the Sixth Form, where students are increasingly well prepared for their next steps.

Most importantly, this report reinforces our belief that continuous improvement is not only desirable but entirely achievable. With the ongoing support of parents and carers, alongside the positive engagement and commitment of our students, we will continue to build on this strong foundation and strive for even greater success.
