TIERS OF INTERVENTION

Here at King's Leadership Phoenix Academy we offer three different tiers of intervention for schools to access:

Tier 2 Renovation

Key Stage 3 short-term 12-week placement to assess and address pupil's needs, with the expectation of the return to their mainstream school.

Tier 3 Restoration

Year 10 12-week placement to assess and address pupil's needs, with the expectation of the return to their mainstream school.

Tier 4 Reformation

Year 11 A permanent placement at the King's Leadership Phoenix Academy to give pupils stability in their final year of school education.

PLACEMENTS

How do the placements work?

Commissioning schools buy an annual place at King's Phoenix through part 1 of our commissioning agreement.

Our tier 2 & 3 places are broken down into three 12-week placements which allows three different pupils to access our interventions throughout the academic year.

For tier 4, placements one pupil who is dual-registered will attend King's Phoenix for the remainder of their school career.

Once the place has been secured, both schools will work together to agree which pupils will benefit best from the placement at King's Phoenix.



EXCELLING AT KING'S PHOENIX

Based on extensive research in the Merseyside area, we have designed an educational package unlike any currently available.

Pupils experiencing Social, Emotional and Mental Health issues (SEMH) have many passive and active behaviours which prevent them from being able to access mainstream education.

At King's Phoenix, we have the expertise to give pupils the personal tools required to return to mainstream whilst continuing an aspirational and academic curriculum.

Social, Emotional and Mental Health behaviours we can support at King's Phoenix

- Refusal to attend school
- Anxiety
- Low mood
- Being withdrawn
- Avoiding risks
- Unable to make choices
- Low self-worth
- Isolated
- Perceived injustices
- Disproportionate reactions to situations
- Difficulties with change/transitions
- Absconding
- Eating issues

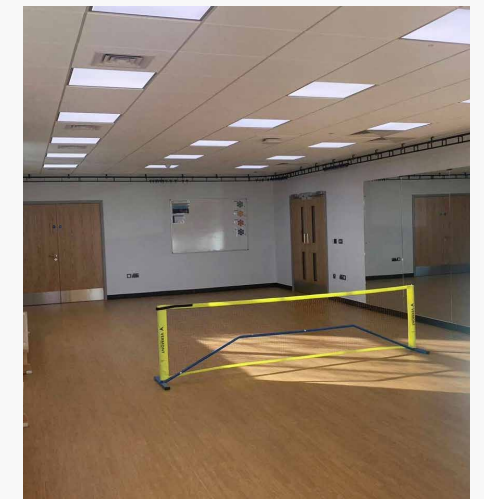
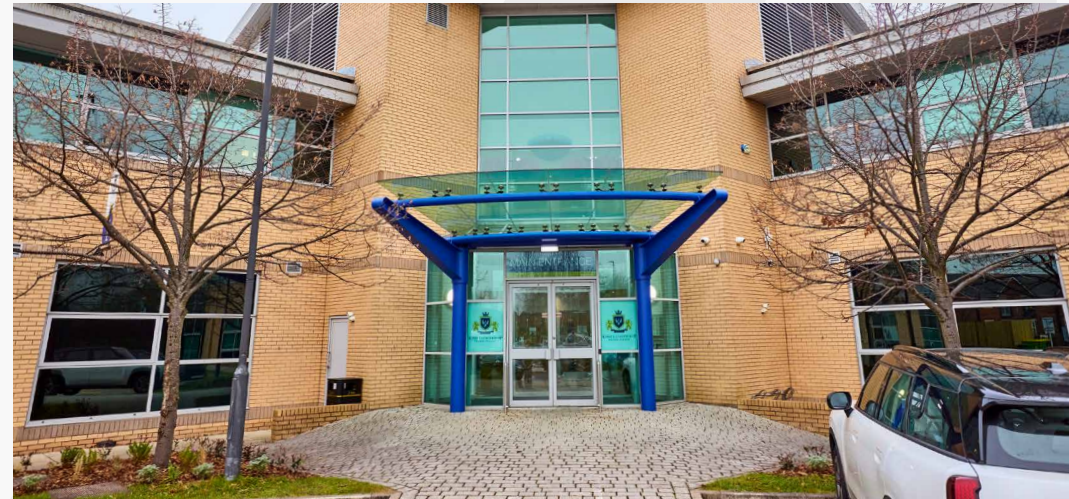
