About Lincoln Carlton Academy

Our vision

Lincoln Carlton is a consistently oversubscribed school, and this strong demand shapes the next phase of its development.

As a highly regarded primary school, Lincoln Carlton balances high expectations with a joyful and nurturing approach to education. Our students benefit from a rich curriculum designed around curiosity, creativity and character development.

As a part of Anthem Schools Trust, Lincoln Carlton Academy is a mixed-gender primary academy for children aged 4 to 11, located at Carlton Boulevard, Lincoln, LN2 4AG. The school currently has 436 pupils on roll. The most recent inspection (April 2025) judged quality of education, behaviour and attitudes, personal development, early years provision and leadership and management all as Good.

16% of pupils receive SEN support and 5% of pupils have an EHCP. 16% of pupils are eligible for free school meals but the school serves a high proportion of hidden disadvantaged families. Demand for places remains strong and the school continues to attract interest from families in the local community.

We emphasise inclusion, relationships and high-quality teaching. Staff wellbeing and professional development are central to how the school operates. We work closely with families and value the strength of our Lincoln community.
