- To play an active role in the life of the school.
- To provide a positive, welcoming classroom environment which is safe, well-organised and conducive to learning so that all children are able to reach their full potential.
- To have, and maintain high expectations of pupils' behaviour and learning, maintaining a good standard of discipline through positive relationships, well-focused teaching and the implementation of the school behaviour policy.
- To uphold the highest standards of communication with colleagues, children and their families.

- To carry out any other duties assigned by the Head Teacher.
