TEACHER AND TUTOR

To fulfil the roles of teacher and tutor as described in the generic job descriptions.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- To lead the Elite Player Development (EPD) programme including overseeing all aspects of the programme including family information evening/s and personalised training programme
- To support the Head of Faculty – Athletic Performance during aptitude test day
- To attend weekly line management meetings with the Head of Faculty – Athletic Performance
- To ensure that the extra-curricular programme, including that of EPD enhances and supports the curriculum within the Athletic Performance Faculty
- To establish, monitor and maintain a clear set of entry requirements for each year group on EPD
- To research and co-ordinate, the possibility of Post 16 sports provision including accessing funding from appropriate sporting bodies
- To be the link point for primary feeder schools in relation to sport, including the leading and co-ordination of the Woodlands Cup
- Plan and co-ordinate an annual trip/visit for Elite players in Year 9 which raise aspirations and offer high level guidance
- To establish an Elite sports calendar with other outstanding sporting schools across the country and regular fixtures
- Ensure all elite performers are aware of County and National trials where appropriate
- To ensure all EPD kit is ordered on time and pupils wear the appropriate kit in every EPD session
- Produce regular updates for weekly parent letter, school displays, website and Twitter on Elite player performance
- To hold Elite Sport Coaches to account for their specific programme
- To liaise with HOF – Athletic Performance to ensure that the curriculum time is used effectively to support Elite Sports Programme
- Any additional responsibilities that are linked to the role as judged by the Head Teacher
