Job Purpose:

As a Mathematics Teacher at Ormiston Latimer Academy, you will play a vital role in inspiring curiosity, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills in students who may have found mainstream education challenging. You will be responsible for delivering engaging and accessible Mathematics lessons that connect theory to real-world applications, helping students build confidence in their abilities and fostering a lifelong interest in scientific discovery and numerical reasoning.

Core Duties:

You are required to perform the duties of a school teacher as set out in the relevant paragraphs of the current Teachers Conditions of Employment document. This includes:

- Teaching Mathematics' across KS3 and KS4 and across the full ability range; following departmental schemes of work, the National Curriculum, and the relevant subject specifications.
- Contributing to the development of departmental schemes of learning.
- Setting and marking homework, in line with academy/departmental policy.
- Integrating the development of key skills (numeracy, literacy, and ICT) into their teaching.
- Monitoring and assessing students, in line with academy/departmental policy.
- Collaborate with other teachers and support staff to create a holistic and individualized approach to student development.
- Provide constructive feedback and support to students, both academically and emotionally, to help them succeed.
- Actively promoting the academy's elevated expectations and equal opportunities policy.
- Contributing to the academy meeting cycle.
- Maintaining a safe, positive, and attractive teaching and learning environment.

Other Duties:

To assist the principal in ensuring that the academy runs smoothly, and acts in a supervision capacity, as the need arises. This includes:

- Helping to always maintain outstanding behaviour around the academy by undertaking daily duties and providing pastoral support for pupils, as appropriate.
- Undertaking the responsibilities of a mentor and attending parent meetings, assemblies.
- Maintaining sound procedures for precautions, supervision, and maintenance of the school environment, ensuring all safeguarding, health and safety regulations are met to a high standard.

Performance Management:

The post holder will participate in the academy's arrangements for Performance Management.

- All staff are part of a wider academy team. Everyone, therefore, is required to support the

 pupils and being flexible in a demanding environment. On occasions the post holder may be
