All of the Social Science subjects are incredibly popular here at Tring School. Criminology (Level 3 Applied Diploma - WJEC) is offered to our post 16 students and is one of the most popular subjects in our Sixth Form, with approximately 70 students studying it in both Yr 12 and in Yr 13. The combination of both exams and NEA make it an ideal choice for students, with many going on to study Criminology at university. Psychology and Sociology (AQA) are also very popular A Level courses, with Sociology also offered as a GCSE. Many of our students choose to study a combination of social science subjects, which is pleasing, and enables us to build strong, supportive relationships with our students.

We are a well organised and well resourced department, with 3 dedicated classrooms, comprehensive teaching resources that are sequenced and planned to best support our students, and a number of very experienced subject specialists. We pride ourselves on providing an exceptionally high quality of teaching and learning to our students, and this is reflected in the high levels of student engagement and student achievements in our subjects. We ensure our classrooms are inclusive for all, and that every student is well supported in achieving their very best. We have excellent IT provision across the school, with all students benefitting from having their own chromebooks, and the use of the Google education suite is integral to our teaching here at Tring School.
