The Teaching Partner will be working within our SEND team, supporting a child in Year 2 and also guiding sessions within our alternative provision, EDEN (Educational Development Emotional Nurture). The role would include working with the school's Inclusion Manager to support children with additional needs, including SEND and SEMH (Social, Emotional, and Mental Health) challenges.

Support will focus on building positive relationships, teaching key objectives and adapting tasks so that pupils can reach their full potential. We are looking for someone who is interested in helping us in our mission and has a passion for working with children.

Perhaps you are looking to return to education or thinking about a move into education. Perhaps you are a teacher looking to remain in a school setting without the stresses of teaching. Perhaps you have completed your teacher training but are yet to be employed into a teaching post.
