Working in the Highfield and Meadow setting means that teachers need to deliver a variety of subjects to pupils from KS3 to KS5 so some range of subject expertise is desirable.

This is an exciting professional development opportunity for a secondary specialist teacher who is an excellent classroom practitioner from either a mainstream or special provision background. The successful candidate will be passionate about teaching their subject to young people who have medical needs, especially those with acute mental health needs, and have a desire to reduce educational disadvantage caused by ill health. Flexibility is important within the school so the ability to teach other subjects where need arises is essential.
