


We believe in being truly inclusive and representative across our schools and so our ambition is to be a trust of up to 40 schools.




At Harbour Learning Trust, we invest extensively in outstanding training and development opportunities. We value our staff and the benefits we offer include:

OUR TALENT, LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY



Learning is critical to how we move forwards as a Trust, to enable our people to be at their best in the job they currently do, and to develop towards a future role.

The majority of what we learn in our profession we learn 'on the job' and this can be structured and defined so that the learning is meaningful and developmental.

Over the last decade we've become much more aware of how much we learn from each other, often called social learning, and which includes how we coach each other, give feedback and build a network that supports learning and development across the Trust.

More traditional development programmes sit alongside these other methods for targeted and focused development at specific stages of someone's career or for specific groups.
