St Columba's College is located 25 miles from Central London in the cathedral city of St Albans in Hertfordshire. The College is a thriving 4-18 independent co-educational day school, comprising a Prep School of approximately 220 pupils and a Senior School of 600 students, of whom 160 are in the Sixth Form.

St Columba's is an independent academic and aspirational school devoted to academic excellence and the holistic development of each individual child. It was established in 1955 by the Brothers of the Sacred Heart and is a Roman Catholic foundation based on the educational philosophy developed by its founder, Father André Coindre: to ensure a provision of education rooted in religious values, structured through friendly discipline, nurtured by personal attention, and committed to academic excellence. We are an integral part of a dynamic group of 12 schools located primarily across the United States.

The Role:

We are seeking a Digital Content Creator to join our Marketing team. This is an exciting opportunity to help showcase all that our school has to offer across multiple platforms.

This role helps to share the energy and spirit of our school community from classroom activities and co-curricular achievements to community events and success stories. The successful candidate will help plan, capture and create engaging content that brings life at St Columba's to our digital audiences.

Key responsibilities:

- Develop and manage creative social media campaigns that align with the marketing strategy across or Prep, Senior and Sixth Form.
- Capture and edit photo and video content for social media, website and digital advertising
- Write engaging copy that reflects the College's tone of voice
- Monitor engagement analytics and suggest ways to enhance performance
- Collaborate with colleagues, pupils and the wider community to source authentic stories and content
- Experience creating high quality content for our digital channels (Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and our website)
- Support Admissions with bespoke campaigns to drive awareness and recruitment
- Ensure brand guidelines are followed and tone of voice used across all campaigns

Safeguarding Children

- Term time plus one week (3 days) to be worked on GCSE and A Level results days in August and Open Day, plus 5 Inset Days. Attendance at the annual Columban Fayre is also required.
- Part-time, 21 hours per week, with core hours of work being 8.15 am to 4.15 pm inclusive of a one-hour unpaid lunch break. The actual working days can be discussed and agreed at interview. Flexibility will be required to ensure that the requirements of the role are fulfilled. Attendance will be required at some evening and weekend events throughout the year to support key College events.
- The starting salary will be dependent upon skills and experience.
- Free lunches and refreshments.
- Contributory Pension Scheme to which the College contributes 6%.
- Free car parking on site.
- Use of the College Fitness Suite outside of school hours.
- Access to confidential 24-hour counselling helpline.
- Cycle to Work and Tech Schemes.
- Eye Care Vouchers.
- Free annual flu vaccination.
- Support with continuing professional development.

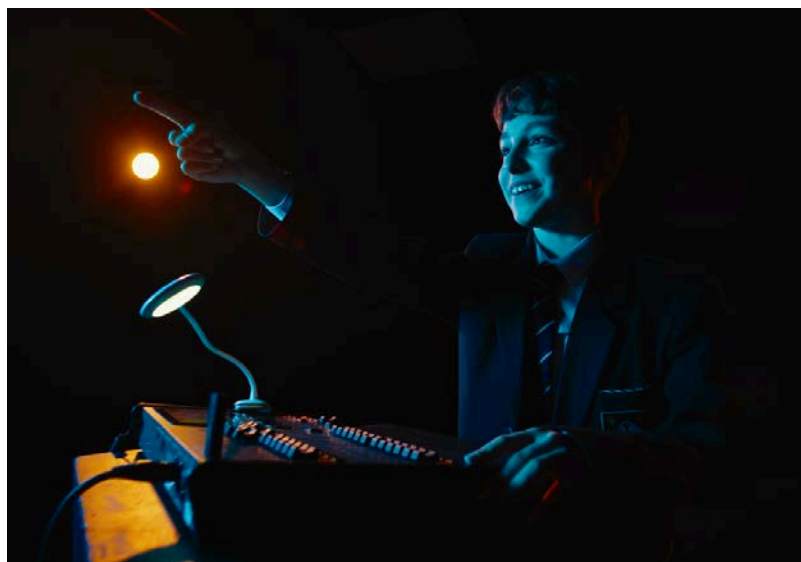
