

Job Description Teacher of Economics

To deliver high-quality teaching of Business and Economics that enables students to achieve excellent academic outcomes and develop a strong understanding of business concepts, economic principles, and real-world commercial and economic issues. The post holder will contribute to the development of the Business and Economics curriculum and support the wider aims and ethos of Alperton Community School.

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful candidate will be an excellent classroom teacher who can inspire and excite students about their learning. They will have an innovative approach to delivering Business and Economics curricula that are inclusive to all students and make good use of ICT.

The successful candidate will be expected:

- To deliver high-quality effective teaching across GCSE Business (Edexcel 9–1), A-Level Business, BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in Business, and A-Level Economics.
- Plan and teach engaging lessons covering key business areas including marketing, finance, operations, human resources, and strategy.
- Plan and deliver engaging, high-quality Economics lessons in line with the school curriculum.
- Teach Economics across Key Stage 5.
- Deliver units from the BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in Business, ensuring full compliance with Pearson requirements.
- Use a variety of teaching strategies to meet the needs of all learners.
- Set high expectations for student achievement and behaviour.
- Use assessment effectively to monitor progress and provide constructive feedback.
- Adapt teaching to support students with different abilities and learning needs.



- Contribute to the planning and development of the Economics curriculum.
- Ensure lessons reflect current economic issues and developments.
- Collaborate with colleagues to share best practice and improve teaching standards.
- Develop high-quality teaching resources and schemes of work.
- Assess, record and report on the progress and attainment of students.
- Use data to inform teaching and support student progress.
- Prepare students effectively for internal and external examinations.
- Provide timely feedback to students and parents.
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- Contribute to curriculum development, quality assurance, and departmental improvement.
- Support enrichment activities, enterprise projects, economics clubs, employer-linked learning, and competitions.

General Duties

- To take part in the school performance review process.
- Participate in departmental meetings, training and professional development activities.
- To support the Governing Body in its whole-hearted adoption of the School's policies, and aims.
- Participate in the wider life of the school, including extracurricular activities such as economics clubs, enterprise competitions, or enrichment activities.
- Attend parents' evenings, school events and professional development days.
- To be a fully trained First Aider or be willing to be trained as an emergency First Aider and to undertake medical needs training and administering of medication.
- To supervise areas where students congregate during break time and lunchtime, maintaining Health & Safety practices.

Whilst every effort has been made to explain the main duties and responsibilities of the post, individual tasks may not have been identified. The post holder will be expected to undertake tasks which are commensurate with the position at the discretion of the Headteacher.

The Job Description may be varied to meet the changing demands of the school. It will be reviewed at intervals and may be subject to modification or amendment at any time after consultation with the post holder.
