




PERSON SPECIFICATION: **Health & Social Care**

- To manage behaviour effectively within the classroom and Department.

- To show confidence, imagination, drive and boundless enthusiasm in teaching.
- The ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing.
- Good personal organisation, administration skills, team work and the ability to work under pressure.
- Use data effectively to ensure progress and raise achievement.
- A commitment to the wider life of the Faculty and the school.
- A commitment to equal opportunities in a multi-cultural, multi-ethnic school
- A willingness to learn new skills & approaches & to share the experiences with others.
