## Specialist Resource Provision – Birch Class

Birch Class is a Specialist Resourced Provision (SRP) designed to support children with complex Communication and Interaction needs, including those on the autism spectrum, who are currently unable to access a full-time mainstream curriculum. Our mission is to nurture each child's potential through a tailored, inclusive approach that meets their individual needs.

At the heart of Birch Class is a nurturing environment where children feel safe, valued, and secure.
