POST TITLE:	Midday Supervisor
GRADE:	Grade 5
HOURS OF WORK:	11.45am - 1.35pm (3 days per week)
RESPONSIBLE TO:	Midday Co-ordinator / Assistant Head of School
RELATIONSHIPS WITH:	Head of School (Primary Phase) / Deputy Head of School Teachers / Teaching Assistants & Support Staff Catering Staff Parents

PURPOSE OF THE JOB:

- To supervise students during the lunch period (both inside and outside)

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Midday Supervision

- Under the direction of the Midday Co-ordinator/Assistant Head of School, supervise students during the lunchtime period in accordance with procedures.
- Contribute to behaviour management within the school, in accordance with the school's Behaviour Policy.
- Inform the Safeguarding, Pastoral & Wellbeing Lead and classroom teaching staff of any concerns regarding a student's behaviour and wellbeing during the lunchtime period.
- Administering First Aid as a qualified First Aider.
- Undertake any other duties consistent with the post.

2. Support for the School

- Attend and actively participate in Staff Meetings.
- Contribute to the maintenance of a safe and healthy environment.
- Contribute and participate in school events and activities.
- Develop and maintain effective working relationships with staff and students.
- Develop and maintain professional relationships with parents regarding lunchtime issues.

GENERAL NOTES:

- The aforementioned responsibilities are subject to the general duties and responsibilities contained in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document, Burgundy Book and other conditions of service for teachers and are additional to the general duties and responsibilities of a teacher.
- These accountabilities do not direct the particular amount of time to be spent on carrying them out and no part of it may be so construed.
- These accountabilities are not necessarily a comprehensive definition of the post. It will be reviewed at least once per year and it may be subject to modification or amendment at any time after consultation with the holder of the post.
