- 1.2 Seek to inspire a love of learning, an intellectual curiosity and independent thinking
- 1.3 Amplify the Student Voice, promoting the value of democratic participation and ensuring there is the space for every learner to be heard
- 1.4 Review the curriculum annually to ensure it remains current and provides for a multitude of progression routes contributing to local, national and global skills needs
- 1.5 Build on existing partnerships and develop new relationships with local/regional and national employers and other strategic partners to enable students to link curriculum learning to progression and careers
- 1.6 Equip students with the skills, attitudes, and workplace behaviours to make them strong contenders for high calibre jobs and apprenticeships
- 1.7 Promote social mobility through targeted interventions with disadvantaged groups

To achieve this, we will:

- 2.1 Develop a shared quality framework across the Trust
- 2.2 Invest, allocating time and resources, to encourage colleagues through shared staff development activities to collaborate, research together, reflect and hone their practice
- 2.3 Facilitate regular team visits, exchanges and cross–college projects that focus on supporting all learners to succeed
- 2.4 Foster a culture of creativity and innovation in *how* things are done and a willingness to question conventions and established practices
- 2.5 Collaborate to continually review and improve academic and administrative processes utilising existing productivity tools and new technology including Al. Identify missing skillsets and invest in staff training needs
- 2.6 Contribute to national research and engage with reputable partners to develop post -16 learning and support
- 2.7 Invite LGB Governors and Trustees to meet students and staff regularly

To achieve this, we will:

- 3.1 Seek to recruit and retain a diverse, skilled staff community who support a rich curriculum and highly effective support services

- 3.3 Identify and nurture future college leaders and plan for succession
- 3.4 Promote a culture that supports staff wellbeing
