Purpose of the Role

In addition, the Raising Standards Leader will work alongside school leaders to promote high standards of teaching, learning, curriculum development and pupil outcomes across the school, with a particular focus on securing strong progress and achievement for all pupils.

The postholder will model excellent classroom practice, contribute positively to school improvement and support a culture of high expectations, collaboration and continuous professional growth.

Key Responsibilities

Teaching and Learning

- Plan and deliver consistently high-quality lessons which engage, challenge and inspire all learners.
- Create a positive, inclusive and ambitious classroom culture where children feel safe, valued and motivated to succeed.
- Secure strong progress and attainment for all pupils through effective teaching, assessment and responsive adaptation.
- Use assessment information effectively to identify next steps, address misconceptions and support pupil progress.
- Prepare pupils effectively for statutory assessment whilst maintaining a broad, balanced and enriching curriculum experience.
- Promote pupils' personal development, confidence, independence and readiness for secondary school.
- Maintain high expectations of behaviour, presentation and attitudes to learning.
- Work collaboratively with colleagues to plan, evaluate and improve teaching and curriculum provision.

Raising Standards Leadership Responsibilities

- Support the Head of School and senior leaders in driving high standards across the school.
- Contribute to school improvement priorities linked to teaching, learning, curriculum and pupil outcomes.

- Model excellent classroom practice and support colleagues through coaching, collaboration and professional dialogue.
- Help to identify barriers to pupil achievement and contribute to strategies which improve outcomes for all learners.
- Support the monitoring and evaluation of standards, including work scrutiny, pupil progress discussions and curriculum development activities where appropriate.
- Contribute to the development of effective assessment and feedback practices.
- Promote a culture of aspiration, accountability and continuous improvement.
- Work collaboratively across the federation to share effective practice and contribute to wider school improvement.

Professional Responsibilities
