



Classroom Teacher – Job Description

Purpose of the role

To deliver high-quality, inclusive teaching that enables all pupils to flourish academically, spiritually, socially and emotionally within the context of the Catholic ethos of the school.

Professional responsibilities

The post-holder will fulfil the duties of a classroom teacher as set out in the Teachers' Standards, the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (STPCD) and the school's policies.

Teaching and learning

- Plan and teach well-sequenced lessons that secure strong progress for all pupils through adaptive teaching.
- Use assessment effectively to identify misconceptions and adapt teaching accordingly.
- Create a classroom environment with high expectations for behaviour and learning.
- Make effective and safe use of digital tools to support learning, assessment and feedback.

Inclusion and SEND

- Take responsibility for the progress of all pupils, including those with SEND, EHCPs, EAL and SEMH needs.
- Work in partnership with the SENDCo and external professionals to remove barriers to learning.
- Apply trauma-informed and relational approaches where appropriate.

Behaviour, safeguarding and wellbeing

- Maintain high standards of behaviour in line with the school Behaviour Policy.
- Fulfil all safeguarding responsibilities, acting promptly on concerns.
- Contribute to a culture that promotes pupil and staff wellbeing.

Professional conduct

Uphold the highest standards of professionalism, equality, confidentiality and integrity at all times.
