We are looking to recruit a Learning Support Assistant who enjoys working with children and has the ability to support them in all aspects of their learning and development. Experience of working in with children with Special Educational Needs would be an advantage. A good standard of literacy and numeracy is essential.

The school is part of the Bentley Wood Trust. Within the school, there are classes from Nursery to Year Six, three classes in each year group; except Year 6 and Year 4 where there are two. The classrooms are spacious, attractive and well-resourced and include a separate an outdoor learning area for the Foundation Stage.

Within the school, we have a specialist resource, Kaleidoscope. The facility supports our pupils who have a diagnosis of Autism. Kaleidoscope has two classrooms, both with interactive whiteboards, a sensory room, soft playroom and multi-purpose life skills room. Through working as a team, we aim to support all our pupils, regardless of needs, to work successfully in mainstream classrooms.
