Main Responsibilities

Teaching and Learning

- Plan and deliver high-quality teaching across the curriculum, in line with the National Curriculum, EYFS Framework (where appropriate), and agreed RE syllabus.
- Create engaging, purposeful learning experiences that inspire curiosity, enjoyment and high achievement.
- Ensure all pupils make strong progress through:
 - clear learning objectives and well-sequenced lessons
 - appropriately challenging tasks for all learners
 - high expectations for effort, presentation and outcomes
 - effective use of prior attainment to inform planning
- Identify and support all learners.

Pupil Development and Wellbeing

- Take responsibility for the **academic, social, emotional and physical wellbeing** of all pupils in your care.
- Contribute to pupils' personal development, including their spiritual, moral, social and cultural understanding.
- Create a safe, inclusive and nurturing classroom environment where all children feel valued and able to succeed.

Assessment and Progress

- Use assessment effectively to inform teaching and ensure strong pupil progress.
- Provide high-quality feedback (both written and verbal) that moves learning forward.
- Maintain accurate records in line with school systems and statutory requirements.
- Meet all expectations around assessment, recording and reporting to parents and leaders.

Behaviour and Classroom Culture

- Establish a calm, purposeful and positive classroom environment.
- Maintain high expectations for behaviour through strong relationships and consistent routines.
- Promote independence, resilience and a love of learning.

Inclusion and SEND

- Work in line with the SEND Code of Practice.
- Contribute to and implement support plans as required.
- Work closely with colleagues, including the SENCO and support staff, to ensure all pupils succeed.

Teamwork and Wider Contribution

- Work collaboratively with colleagues, support staff and leaders.
- Make effective use of Teaching Assistants and other adults in the classroom.
- Contribute to wider school life (e.g. trips, events, enrichment opportunities).

- Lead or contribute to a subject area, as agreed.

Professional Responsibilities

- Attend staff meetings, parents' evenings and other school events.
- Engage actively in professional development and reflective practice.
