Art & Design Technology Teacher

Job Purpose

To be responsible for the learning, progress and achievement of all students in allocated Art & Design Technology classes, delivering engaging lessons that inspire creativity, develop practical skills and support excellent outcomes.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

Teaching & Learning

- Teach Art and Design Technology according to students' educational needs across allocated key stages.
- Plan and prepare high-quality lessons, units of work and curriculum materials.
- Set, mark and assess classwork and homework.
- Assess, record and report on student progress, attainment and development.
- Promote the overall well-being and academic progress of students.
- Communicate effectively with parents/carers and external agencies.
- Contribute to written and verbal reports, references and assessments.
- Keep up to date with subject and curriculum developments.
- Maintain a safe, organised and stimulating learning environment, including specialist studios and workshops.

Professional Responsibilities

- Participate in performance management and appraisal.
- Engage fully in professional development and training.
- Contribute to departmental and whole-school meetings.
- Support the review, development and enhancement of curriculum provision and resources.



- Work collaboratively with colleagues to drive improvement across the department and wider school community.

Classroom Management

- Maintain high standards of behaviour and discipline.
- Promote high standards of literacy across teaching.
- Ensure safe and appropriate use of tools, equipment and materials.
- Deploy and support Teaching Assistants effectively.
- Take responsibility for the use and care of classroom and specialist resources.

Additional Duties

- Register student attendance.
- Provide cover for absent colleagues within STPCD guidelines.
- Support school activities, enrichment and broader educational experiences.
- Uphold school policies including safeguarding and child protection.
