

We're a regional destination for the 18 million people who live within 60 minutes' travel, with an award-winning gallery, theatre, numerous live music venues including The Stables (one of the most popular venues in the country) a resident orchestra, 270 pieces of public art, and a diverse selection of museums and heritage attractions, most famously Bletchley Park which celebrates the incredible achievements of Britain's World War II codebreakers. Xscape features indoor skiing and snowboarding, indoor sky-diving, rock-climbing, a multiplex cinema, retail outlets, and bars and restaurants. If you're a football fan, MK is home to Milton Keynes Dons FC, and you can watch League Two football in the 30,000 capacity state-of-the-art stadium.
