



Independence: we strive to meet our potential with resilience, determination, self reflection and self discipline



Living in the Area

Ashlyns School is located on the edge of the historic market town of Berkhamsted in south west Hertfordshire, recently named 'The Sunday Times best place to live in the south east of England'. Berkhamsted is surrounded by Chiltern countryside, is within easy reach of London (30 minutes to Euston by rail) and has great transport links with M25, M1 and A41.

We have lovely staff accommodation for colleagues moving to the area, subject to availability, in our on-site lodges.

Berkhamsted is easily commutable from many nearby towns including Aylesbury, Hemel Hempstead, Luton, St Albans and Watford.
