Education, Qualifications and Training:

- Qualified Teacher Status (essential).
- Evidence of on-going professional development.

Desirable Experience, Knowledge and Skills:

- Teaching that is at least good.
- Knowledge and experience of the curriculum for the primary age range.
- Skills necessary to motivate pupils across all ability levels.
- Understanding of what constitutes high quality provision.
- A robust understanding of Safeguarding and Child Protection issues.
- Accurate and robust assessment
- Ability to assess pupils' work accurately.
- Excellent behaviour management skills (ideally with Herts STEPS training)
- Ability to work as part of an effective team and motivate others.
- Ability to solve everyday problems by using initiative and flexibility while working under pressure and remaining calm.
- Excellent time management skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively with children, colleagues, parents, governors and the wider community.
