Welcome from our Student Leaders

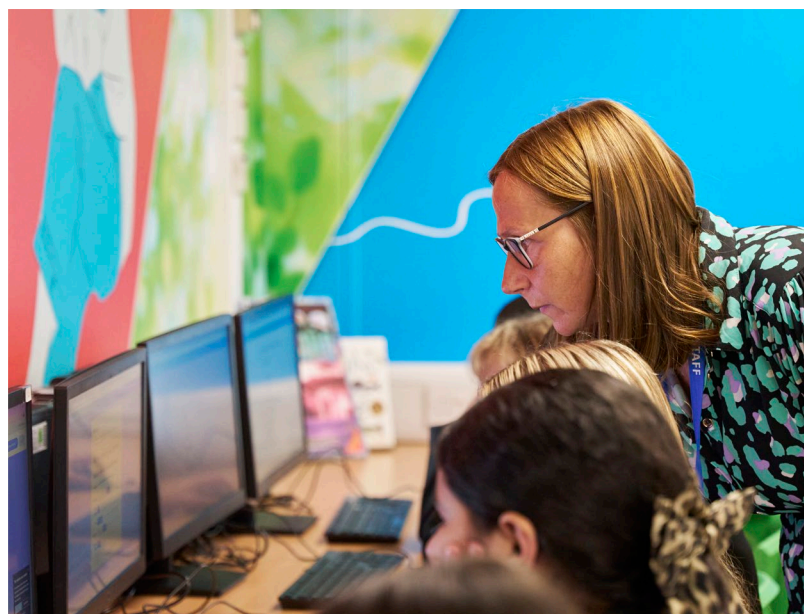
Anaya Patel, Head Student
