



PERFORMING ARTS DEPARTMENT - MUSIC

The Performing Arts Department at Teign School is an enthusiastic, energetic and successful department.

At Key Stage 3 Music is taught to Years 7, 8 and 9 in mixed ability teaching groups. Each pupil at Key Stage 3 receives 2 x 60-minute lessons over two weeks. During Key Stage 3 we aim for each pupil to have the opportunity to experience Music and Drama outside of the classroom and have many extra-curricular and performing opportunities throughout the year including a large musical and 3 music concerts. We have a growing choir and various small groups who perform at each concert alongside our solo students. We have a team of Visiting Music Tutors who offer a range of instruments and voice for students to take up on an individual basis.

At Key Stage 4 Music is a popular subject with approximately 20 students opting in both Years 10 and 11 for the BTEC course. We strongly encourage KS4 students to take a role in the enrichment opportunities.

At Key Stage 5 Music is taught to both Y12 and 13 together studying the Level 3 BTEC Music Performance course.

The Music classrooms are at one end of the Performing Arts block. There are 2 main classrooms and 5 smaller practise rooms. As with all curriculum areas, there are designated weekly, half termly meetings scheduled, as well as collaborating with other Geography teachers across Education South West, both through allocated after-school sessions and INSET days.
