- **Training Delivery:** Plan, structure, and deliver an engaging weekly 1-hour training session every Monday afternoon (4:00 PM - 5:00 PM)
- **Match Day Coaching:** Lead, coach, and manage the team during Wednesday afternoon fixtures (home and away).
- **Student Transport:** Safely drive the college minibus to transport players to and from away fixtures. (Requires a full UK Driving Licence, but no special additions or D1 category are necessary).
- **Student Development:** Motivate, encourage, and enthuse students of all skill levels, ensuring a welcoming environment that values sportsmanship and personal growth.
