Thank you for considering the post of Headteacher at St Nicholas and St Laurence CE Primary School, part of the Diocese of Salisbury Academy Trust (DSAT) which comprises twenty-eight schools. The school is located north of Weymouth town centre and takes children from the surrounding area. We are blessed to work in this attractive seaside town, which is part of the outstanding Jurassic Coast, a World Heritage Site. We are based on the Wey Valley Campus which comprises St Nicholas and St Laurence CE Primary, Wyvern School, The Wey Valley Academy and Scallywags Childcare Centre. Many of our children enter Reception from Scallywags and the vast majority leave Year 6 to go to Wey Valley Academy. We are a very popular school offering a variety of wrap around care. Currently we are oversubscribed with 213 children.

Our vision statement: **"Inspire to aspire - Life in all its fullness"** was created by the school community. We want to inspire all our children to take on new learning, new experiences, new responsibilities, new challenges so they can become the very best they can be. Our core values are **hope, perseverance, fellowship, compassion, resilience and love** and we live them out as a flourishing church school. We have very strong links with our two churches and our immediate community.

The school has been part of DSAT since July 2022 and is part of the Bay Hub comprising St John's, St Andrew's, Beechcroft St Paul's, St Michael's Lyme Regis and Beaminster St Mary's. You will work in collaboration with a range of stakeholders across DSAT to enable us to achieve the Trust's vision of going **"Beyond expectations for all of God's children"**.
