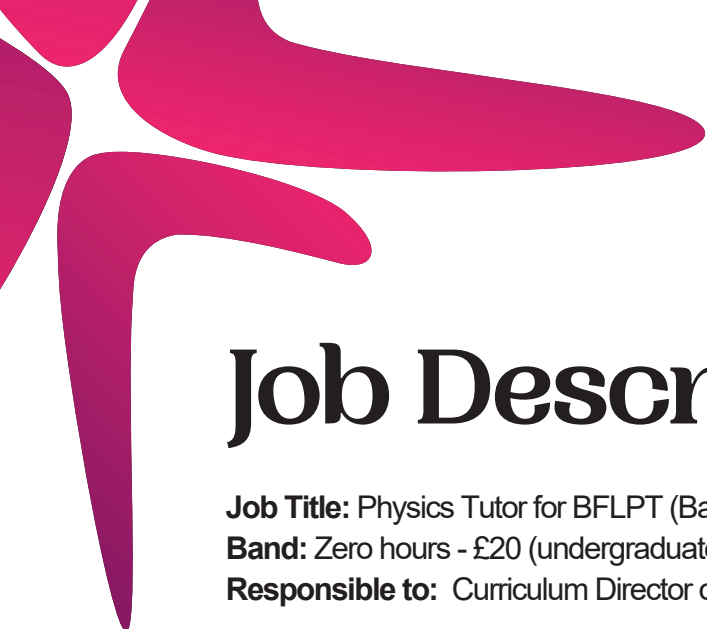

Job Title: Physics Tutor for BFLPT (Based at Doncaster UTC)

Purpose of the Role

Key Responsibilities

Teaching and Learning:

- Deliver engaging and effective A Level Physics tuition to individuals and small groups.
- Support students in developing a secure understanding of biological concepts and processes.
- Plan and prepare learning materials that meet the requirements of the relevant examination specification.
- Adapt teaching approaches to accommodate different learning styles and abilities.
- Provide targeted support for students requiring intervention, revision, or stretch and challenge activities.
- Develop students' examination skills, including interpretation of data, application of knowledge, and extended response writing.

Student Progress:

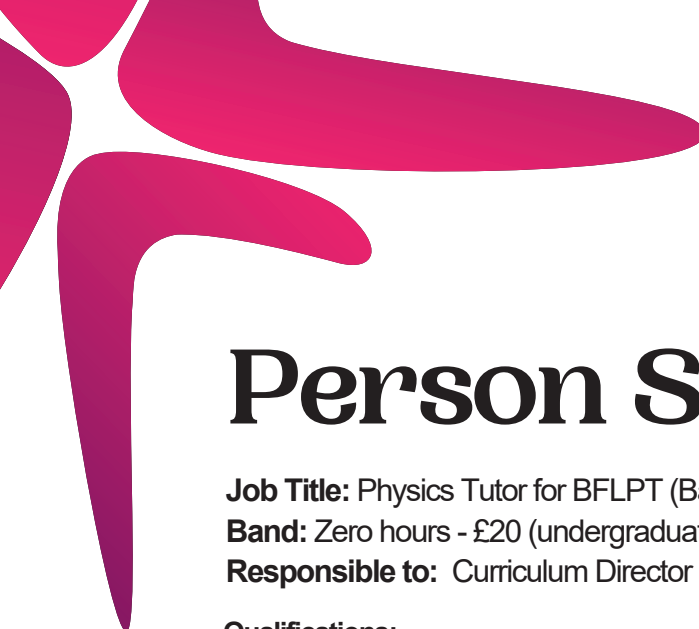
- Assess students' strengths and areas for development.

- Help students set realistic academic goals and develop effective study habits.

- Keep up to date with developments in Physics education and examination specifications.

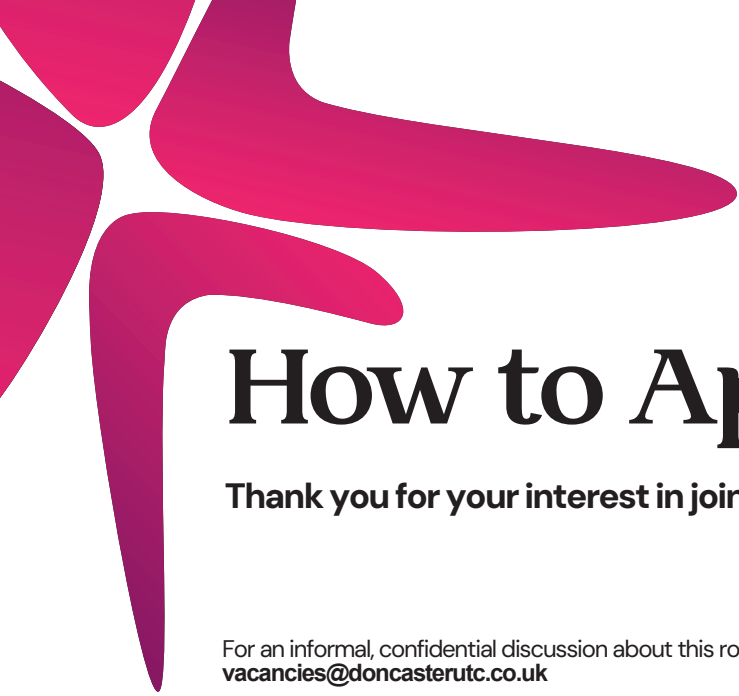
