About the School

Downe House is one of the UK's leading boarding and day schools for girls aged 11 to 18. With a charm and character of its own, the School is set on a beautiful 110 – acre site in the village of Cold Ash situated 3 miles from the market town of Newbury. The School is passionate about creating a strong learning and inspirational environment and community, where every individual matters.

Downe House was founded by Olive Willis in 1907, who held a strong belief that a school should meet the needs of young women proving educational excellence in a framework which was relaxed but structured. With over 550 pupils, approximately 30% of whom are international students, Downe House lives out the message that "each individual matters", alongside the core values of kindness and respect for others. The aim is also to prepare girls to play a full and positive role as citizens of a global community and to become outstanding women of the future.

Our immersive education gives girls the freedom and space to nurture their talents at their own pace. Inspirational teaching, enriching Co-Curricular opportunities and personalised curricula bring out the best in each girl, with holistic pastoral support. The lifelong friendships formed here create an unrivalled network of talented alumnae helping each other succeed beyond Downe House.

The School has a reputation for academic excellence as well as outstanding pastoral care. We offer a flexible approach to suit the individual needs of our pupils and their parents, and girls have the choice of joining us as full boarders, flexi boarders or day girls. Many of the girls are boarders and they live in one of the twelve on-site boarding houses. The emphasis is very much on creating a 'home from home' environment and each house is staffed by a committed and caring team of staff – some of whom are residential.

Our international focus reflects our commitment and ambition to share our education management expertise on a global scale and to provide genuine opportunities for staff and young people all over the world. Academic staff have the opportunity to participate in the Global Teacher Exchange program, with our partner school in Australia. Selected pupils can also attend international schools for a short term or gain global internships for work experience. We are committed to creating a diverse and global community within our founding School in Berkshire, alongside our international schools in Oman and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia as well as our pioneering online DH Academy.

The position

GRADUATE BOARDING ASSISTANT

Start Date: September 2026

Contract Type: 1st September 2026 - 31st July 2028

Salary: £18,912 per annum, plus free on-site accommodation and meals (salary review due September 2026)

Hours: Full time position, term-time only (34 weeks per year plus a few additional days before the start of term for INSET and start of term preparations).

Reporting To: Housemistress (Lower School)

JOB PURPOSE

- Be a member of the team of House Staff in the Lower School Boarding House (Remove and Lower 4 - Years 7 and 8) and to make a positive contribution in all areas concerning the welfare of the boarders.
- Reside within the House during term time (34 weeks per year), apart from agreed time off, and be on duty in the House to provide support for the girls at key times during the day, evening and weekends.
- Organise and deliver a range of activities for the girls, assist with morning and bedtime routines and help keep the Boarding House looking its best at all times.
- Due to the nature of the role and the working hours required, this is a residential post, and the Graduate Assistant will be required to live in one of our Boarding Houses, or in a self-contained flat with other Graduate Assistants during term time.

DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

Each girl in the Lower School becomes a member of one of our Boarding Houses and benefits from all the fun, competitions, challenges and activities that House membership brings.

Our Lower School Boarding Houses are situated on the edge of the woodland in an attractive setting, bringing our Lower School pupils and staff together in a dedicated area which has been specifically designed to meet the pastoral and educational needs of this important age group. The Boarding Houses have been carefully planned to provide comfortable and practical bedroom facilities, homely kitchens and common room spaces. Each House also includes dedicated space for independent study and music practice. Garden play areas allow the girls freedom in a beautiful woodland setting.

We are privileged to have excellent sports facilities which staff and pupils can take advantage of including tennis and squash courts, newly renovated gym, dance studio, indoor heated swimming pool, netball courts and 110-acre estate with ample woodland for nature walks or running.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES


- Be responsible to the Housemistress for the general welfare and personal development of all the boarders in the House and to build appropriate supportive relationships with the girls helping their academic and pastoral sides of School life.
- Encourage involvement and provide the girls with interesting and fun Co-Curricular weekend and evening activities e.g. creative, fitness, musical, sport, or similar depending on your skills and experience.
- Work closely with the House Team and girls to ensure that the House is clean, tidy and well presented at all times.
- Assist with the bedtime and wake-up routines in the House and support girls with their prep.
- Assist any pupils studying Music to ensure that adequate time is given to Music practice.
- Supervise the girls in preparing for games and sports activities.
- Respond to the needs of parents as directed by the Housemistress.
- Carry out administrative and IT tasks for the benefit of the House Team.
- Promote high standards of behaviour amongst the pupils in the House and inform the Housemistress of any matter of serious concern.

- Liaise with the Housemistress regarding the general health and lifestyle of the boarders, assist with administering medication, as per training given and inform the Medical Centre in case of individual illness.
- Respond to the needs of parents as directed by the Housemistress.
- Support another Department for approximately 10 hours pw, this is likely to involve administration and IT duties.
- Maintain high personal standards of timekeeping and an appropriate professional appearance acting as a role model for pupils.
- Attend all relevant staff meetings and INSET days, and any major School events as required

Throughout their time at Downe House, students are encouraged to be aspirational, inter-dependent and compassionate learners through taking part in a variety of activities including Art, DT, Music, Dance, Drama and Sport to build confidence and develop lifelong skills for their overall wellbeing and enjoyment. In our supportive and inclusive environment, students are encouraged to problem solve, embrace challenges and learn to work collaboratively with others. Our goal is to empower our girls to be world-ready young women who will contribute positively to the global community, embodying these values through a lifelong engagement in learning through diverse means.
