# About the School

Downe House is one of the UK's leading boarding and day schools for girls aged 11 to 18. With a charm and character of its own, the School is set on a beautiful 110-acre site in the village of Cold Ash situated 3 miles from the market town of Newbury. The School is passionate about creating a strong learning and inspirational environment and community, where every individual matters.

Downe House was founded by Olive Willis in 1907, who held a strong belief that a school should meet the needs of young women by prizing the individual and creating a strong community. With over 550 pupils, Downe House lives out the message that "each individual matters", an ethos as strong today as it was over 100 years ago, alongside the core values of kindness and respect for others. The aim is also to prepare girls to play a full and positive role as citizens of a global community and to become outstanding women of the future.

Our immersive education gives girls the freedom and space to nurture their talents at their own pace. Inspirational teaching, enriching co-curricular opportunities and personalised curricula bring out the best in each girl, with holistic pastoral support. The lifelong friendships formed here create an unrivalled network of talented alumnae helping each other succeed beyond Dowe House.

The School has a strong reputation for academic excellence as well as outstanding pastoral care. We offer a flexible approach to suit the individual needs of our pupils and their parents, and girls have the choice of joining us as full boarders, flexi boarders or day girls. Many of the girls are boarders and they live in one of the twelve on-site boarding houses. The emphasis is very much on creating a 'home from home' environment and each house is staffed by a committed and caring team of staff – some of whom are residential.

Our international focus reflects our commitment and ambition to share our education management expertise on a global scale and to provide genuine opportunities for staff and young people all over the world. Academic staff have the opportunity to participate in a global teacher exchange program, with our partner school in Australia. Selected pupils can also attend an international school for a short term or gain global internships for work experience. We are committed to creating a diverse and global community within our founding School in Berkshire, alongside our international schools in Oman and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia as well as our pioneering online DH Academy.



# The Science Department

The Science department is made up of a team of nineteen highly qualified and committed members of staff. The department is housed within a purpose-built Science School, which includes eight fully equipped, modern laboratories designated for Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Lower School Science. We are also fortunate to have four prep rooms and four specialist technicians on hand to support our teachers with lesson and equipment preparation.

Our Chemistry Department is very well equipped, allowing teachers to deliver practicals that elsewhere are often delivered as demonstrations.

All students enrol onto the IGCSE Chemistry course (Edexcel). At A level, Chemistry remains a popular choice at Downe House with three A level classes per year group.

Our Science students are highly motivated with a strong work ethic and are curious and eager to learn. The Head of STEM leads The Science Club and student-led societies are run by STEM seniors. Additionally, students participate in a range of prestigious competitions to enrich their learning experience and extend their engagement with the subject beyond the classroom. These include the Chemistry Olympiad, Cambridge Chemistry Challenge, Chemistry Race, RSC Top of the Bench Competition, RSC Schools' Analyst Competition, and a variety of essay competitions.

Many of our pupils continue with Science-based courses at University, such as Medicine and Biochemistry. Each year pupils obtain places to read scientific subjects at top universities including Oxford, Cambridge, Imperial College and UCL.

#### **JOB PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW**

This is an exceptional opportunity to join a friendly team working in well-equipped laboratories in a pleasant environment.

This role has specific responsibility for providing a Chemistry Technician service to the Science Faculty by preparing for all lessons and practical experiments up to and including A' Level classes. Reporting to the Head of Chemistry, but working as part of a team of technicians, you'll be expected to work independently, managing your own prep room and supporting colleagues.

The department is located in a spacious and modern building which boasts four prep rooms and eight specialist science labs.

## **MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Contribute to assessment, monitoring and review of health and safety procedures in line with CLEAPSS.
- Provide technical advice and support on health and safety issues to teaching staff including use of hazards and risk assessments.
- Keep up to date with current procedures through continuing professional development.
- Safely dispose of waste materials.
- Organise, store and check the condition of chemicals and equipment.
- Support the General Science Technician when required in the preparation of apparatus for Chemistry lessons in other classes.
- Ensure the availability of suitable materials and equipment for all chemistry lessons.

- Keep detailed record of the Chemistry Department budget and stock lists and liaise with the Head of Chemistry regarding the sourcing and ordering of equipment, chemicals and materials.
- Keep an accurate record of textbooks issued and provide details of lost or damaged books.
- Contribute to the design, development and maintenance of specialist resources and/or long term projects.
- Under the guidance of the Lead Technician, ensure that both routine and non-routine checking, cleaning, maintenance, calibration, testing and repairing of equipment are carried out to the required standard.
- Participate in departmental meetings and Technicians' meetings, as required by the Head of Science / Head of Chemistry.
- Contribute to the preparation and implementation of the Departmental Development Plan.

- The postholder will be an experienced Chemistry Technician or an individual who has worked in a practical Chemistry environment and can demonstrate competence in reagent preparation, equipment set-up, safe systems of work (COSHH/CLEAPSS), and day-to-day lab support.
- Good working knowledge of Microsoft Office suite software and good levels of literacy and numeracy.
- Efficiency, reliability, and excellent organisational skills - methodical and systematic in organising all workloads and individual tasks.
- The ability to prioritise and meet deadlines, multitask and recall information and facts with good attention to detail.
- Ability to be flexible and proactive to work within a dynamic and busy department.
- Resilient with good problem-solving skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills, able to develop appropriate relationships when working with pupils and colleagues.
- Able to meet Health and Safety requirements and guidelines.

- A genuine interest and enthusiasm for working in a school environment.


#### **DESIRABLE**
