Job Title: Minibus Driver
Reports to: Transport & Logistics Manager

Role purpose:

To operate the school minibuses and provide a collection and delivery service for school staff and pupils. You will report directly to the Transport & Logistics Manager.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Drive school minibuses for collection and delivery of pupils as directed by the Transport & Logistics Manager.
- To assist with maintenance of the fleet of school minibuses drawing any concerns to the attention of the Transport & Logistics Manager and delivering/collecting to maintenance depots where required.
- To complete daily vehicle safety checks, mileage logbooks and pupil registers.
- To provide a courteous, friendly service to all stakeholders both internal and external.

Safeguarding

- The school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share in this commitment.
- Understand and implement the Child Protection Policies of the school and attend related training.

Salary and Benefits

Salary and Working Pattern

We are looking to appoint two Minibus Drivers in the following part time, permanent positions:

25 hours per week over 34 weeks per annum. Working hours will be Monday to Friday, 7am to 9:30am and 3pm to 5:30pm. The salary for this position is £12,713 per annum.

15 hours per week over 34 weeks per annum. Working hours will be Monday to Friday, 6am to 9am. The salary for this position is £7,629 per annum.

Flexibility in working hours and pattern is required to meet the changing needs of the school.

Pension

Subject to meeting the qualifying conditions, support staff are eligible for the Aegon pension scheme. The school will contribute 8% if the staff contributes a minimum of 4% of their salary into the scheme. Please note that this is a defined-contribution pension scheme.

Healthcare

Staff may benefit from a heavily subsidised private healthcare plan. To join, a full-time member of staff has to contribute £100 per annum. The spouse and dependent children may also join the scheme at the prevailing corporate rate.

Lunch

Staff may enjoy a complimentary lunch in the school's Refectory during term-time.

Personal Development

As a learning community, the school looks to invest in and develop staff with creative use of staff training days. We promote a 'coaching culture', encouraging the development and use of coaching skills. We aim to be flexible in our approach, recognising that 'good' and 'effective' CPD looks different at different stages in our careers and lives. The school offers free access to online CPD providers alongside individual-specific CPD opportunities, which are generous and include use of Sabbaticals.

Salary Sacrifice Schemes

Norwich School offers the Cycle to Work scheme.

NOTE: Please note that Norwich School is in the centre of Norwich with very limited parking. The successful candidate may apply for a parking space, but success will be dependent on availability and on meeting the school's criteria for awarding parking spaces. However, the school is well served by public transport systems. Bus stops are located just outside the Cathedral gates and there are frequent services for the various park and ride car parks as well as for other parts of the city and county. The Norwich mainline train station is only 5-10 minutes' walk from the school.
