Main Duties

The purpose of the Maths Teacher's role is to work with the Principal and Academy Representative Body to:

- Deliver high-quality teaching to pupils in KS2 and KS3, enabling them to develop a broad, engaging and secure understanding of Mathematics.
- Demonstrate excellent subject knowledge and communicate this in an enthusiastic and imaginative way in both practical and theoretical lessons.
- Provide the highest possible standards of teaching and learning, promoting the spiritual and moral development of the pupils in your care.
- Ensure that all activities for which you are responsible adhere to the mission statement and aims of the school.
- Contribute to the development of the school as an evangelising, catechetical and educational community.

General Duties and Responsibilities

- Carry out the statutory duties as set out in the current School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document and in accordance with the procedures and guidelines adopted by the Governing Body.
- Meet the Teachers' Standards.
- Contribute to the Catholic life of the school community, rooted in the Eucharistic community it serves.

Classroom Practice

- Be responsible for the day-to-day management and teaching of your classes.
- Ensure the highest possible quality learning environment, reflecting the Catholic nature of the school as outlined in the Mission Statement.
- Conduct teaching and learning in an atmosphere of affirmation, encouragement, appropriate challenge and reflective practice.
- Affirm and support parents in their role as the first educators of their children and maintain effective communication with them.
- Assess, record and monitor each pupil's progress in line with school procedures and use outcomes to inform planning.
- Mark and monitor classwork and homework, providing constructive feedback and setting targets for further progress.
- Regularly evaluate your own teaching practice to consolidate strengths and improve effectiveness.
- Take responsibility for designated areas of health and safety and report any concerns to the Principal.
- Periodically, positively evaluate your own teaching to consolidate strengths and improve effectiveness when appropriate
- To be responsible for the specific areas of the school in relation to health and safety issues and report any concerns to the Principal.

Other Professional Requirements

- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with colleagues, recognising the importance of mutual support.
- Participate in meetings with colleagues and parents as required.
- Take responsibility for your own professional development and ongoing formation.
- Maintain a healthy balance between professional and personal responsibilities.
- Demonstrate secure subject knowledge and understanding.
- Be familiar with and adhere to all school policies, including safeguarding, child protection, health and safety, and current SEND codes of practice.

Other

- Engage in continuous professional development to meet the evolving demands of the role.
- Support the Catholic ethos of the school/Multi Academy Company by promoting its vision and values and modelling personal integrity and professionalism.
- Adhere to all school policies and procedures.
- Undertake other duties as reasonably required within the general scope of the post. Duties outside this scope will only be undertaken with the agreement of the post holder.

The Multi Academy Company reserves the right to require you to work at such other locations as may reasonably be required, subject to reasonable notice.

The MAC reserves the right to require you to work at such other place or places as it may reasonably require from time to time subject to the provision of reasonable notice.
