The socio-economic context of the academy places it in the 5th quintile for deprivation, with 45% of students attracting additional Pupil Premium funding and more than 20% of students having special educational needs. Such complexity brings both challenge and opportunity; if you would like to make a significant difference to young people and are passionate about social mobility, then you will feel real satisfaction and love working at WA.

I am very proud that at WA we now have four staff with the SENCo qualification, and a brilliant team of teaching assistants and safeguarding leads. Ensuring that *all* students are supported to make strong progress through the curriculum is a key focus within the academy.
