Job Title: Teacher of PE

Grade: Main Scale

Job Purpose:

To deliver high quality PE lessons in KS3 and KS4, including supervision and fixtures; to secure the highest levels of learner interest and achievement; to monitor and support the overall development of pupils as a form tutor.

Relationships:

The post holder is responsible to the Head Teacher in all matters, to the Subject Leader in respect of curricular matters and Pastoral team in pastoral matters.

The post holder also interacts on a professional level with colleagues and seeks to establish and maintain productive relationships with them. The main objective of the team, within which the post holder works, is to improve the quality of teaching and learning in the school.

Teaching and learning:

Deliver consistently high quality teaching and learning experiences that lead to high levels of progress, learner interest and enjoyment;
Keep up to date with developments in the subjects and in teaching.

Assessment:

Ensure that pupils are assessed accurately, in order to track pupil attainment;
Make summative and formative records of pupil attainment;
Regularly assess pupils' work so they know what they need to do to improve and help them act on this information to improve progress.

Curriculum planning:

Produce high quality lesson and short-term teaching plans with supporting resources for own classes;
Share planning and resources with other teachers as necessary.

Communication:

Ensure effective communication with parents of pupils;
Liaise with colleagues at Fulbrook, as well as those in lower schools, other middle schools and upper schools as appropriate.

Additional duties:

The post holder may be required to fulfil the role of form teacher and mark class attendance registers. The post holder will play a full part in the life of Fulbrook, to support its vision and ethos, as well as encourage staff and students to follow this example; follow the policies and procedures as agreed by the Governing Body of Fulbrook; undertake any other duties as specified by the Head Teacher.
