	<b>Class teacher</b>
<b>Purpose:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To carry out duties of the Teacher in accordance with the Teachers pay and conditions document and other relevant statutory provisions.</li> <li>• To implement and deliver an appropriate broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for pupils in line with the requirements of KS1 curriculum and school policies.</li> <li>• To share in the development of the curriculum, teaching methods and materials</li> <li>• To support and contribute to the school's responsibility for safeguarding children</li> </ul>
<b>Responsible to:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Head teacher and members of the Senior management team in her absence</li> </ul>
<b>Teaching Duties:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To plan and prepare lessons appropriate to the educational need of the children in KS1.</li> <li>• To teach the children in KS1 according to their educational need, including the setting and marking of work.</li> <li>• To promote the general progress and well-being of pupils and ensure a high quality learning experience for all.</li> <li>• To set high expectations for pupil behaviour through use of the school's behaviour policy.</li> <li>• To assess, record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils</li> <li>• To keep and maintain record keeping systems of pupil development and attainment in line with the school's policy.</li> </ul>
<b>Other duties:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To communicate effectively with parents of pupils</li> <li>• To communicate and co-operate with other professionals, including fellow staff and colleagues from external agencies</li> <li>• To participate in meetings that relate to the curriculum, administration or the organisation of the school.</li> <li>• To be responsible for the coordination of a subject area across school.</li> <li>• To undertake any further duties that the Head teacher may reasonably ask.</li> <li>• To play a full part in the life of the school and be fully supportive of the school ethos</li> </ul>
