Qualifications:

- Good general education - minimum of GCSE (or equivalent) Grade 5/C or above in English and Maths (E)
- Demonstrate a passion for Mathematics and how this can be used to inspire students (E)
- Mathematics qualification (D)

Experience:

- Knowledge of safeguarding and child protection including Keeping Children Safe in Education (Statutory Guidance) (E)
- Experience of working in an education setting supporting students and delivering maths interventions (D)
- Experience of supporting SEND students (D)
- Experience of Entry Level Maths (D)
- Knowledge of special educational needs, disabilities, physical, health and social/emotional needs (D)

Skills:

- Excellent interpersonal skills both in working relationships with children and young people and in forming effective professional relationships with a wide range of contacts (E)
- Excellent planning and organisational skills (E)
- Ability to work independently and flexibly using own initiative (E)
- To work under the authority of the maths teachers (E)
- Good team player (E)
- Confident use of basic computer software e.g. MS Word, Power point and to be prepared to train to use specialised software (E)
- Organised and efficient recording and documentation of student progress (E)
- Have a genuine desire to improve the progress of children and young people with disabilities in Mathematics (E)
