- To maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of curriculum requirements.
 - To develop and enhance the teaching practice of others who teach Mathematics.
- To work with the Head of Mathematics to improve the outcomes for Mathematics.
- To plan for intervention when required to improve teaching and learning.
- To work with colleagues in joint planning and teaching within an identified area.
- To work with colleagues to ensure appropriate enrichment opportunities are available to students.
- To engage in the process of continuing professional development, in order to keep knowledge, skills and understanding updated.
- To assist with the department provision of CPD, QA, PMR as required.
