

JOB DESCRIPTION: Art Technician within ADT Faculty

PURPOSE: To support the Design, Technology and Art Faculty, under the direction of the

Head of Technology/Art faculty.

RESPONSIBLE TO: Head of Art Department

DISCLOSURE LEVEL: Enhanced

SALARY/GRADE: NJC 4-6, pro rata

WORKING TIME: 14.5 hours per week, spread over three days, term time only.

MAIN DUTIES

To support teaching and learning across the faculty (& the school – final point) by:

- Check emails and respond to these in a timely fashion
- Advise and assist students with their practical work during lessons where appropriate
- Establishing the organisation and inventory of materials, equipment and consumables across the faculty
- Managing the ordering and receiving of equipment and materials ensuring they are put away on receipt
- Managing the art budget as directed by HoD
- To prepare materials accurately for lessons and assist students with cutting requirements
- Assist teaching staff by setting up materials when required and clearing away leaving art studios tidy at the end of the day
- Maintenance of Art equipment ensuring it is safe to use and replacing when necessary
- To load, programme and unload the kiln
- Check Health & Safety issues
- Ensuring equipment is ready for PAT testing
- Regular filing
- Preparation and printing of student resources/exam papers using ICT
- Photocopying and distribution of general information
- Inputting data using the school's ICT systems
- Responsibility for the mounting, hanging and display of work around the school; including the corridors, heart space, and rooms when requested
- Preparing paperwork for school trips.
