Education

Business

SCHOOL SUPPORT & IMPROVEMENT

Our School Support & Improvement Team have created a support framework that ensures our schools are continually improving and providing the best possible education for all of our learners.

Peer Reviews

We organise constructive peer reviews between staff members with similar job roles across Aspire, fostering a collaborative environment where staff can share best practices and provide valuable feedback.

External Reviews

We engage external specialists to conduct comprehensive school reviews focusing on specific areas of teaching and learning, ensuring we receive objective insights and recommendations.

PLP Network

Aspire boasts a network of Primary Lead Practitioners (PLPs) who are experts in their fields. These PLPs lead initiatives and provide specialised support to enhance teaching practices across Aspire.

Spotlight Discussions

Each school has an Academy Improvement Plan (AIP). These meetings provide a platform to discuss their AIP's, considering progress, challenges and strategies to achieve school improvement goals.

SSIT Evaluation

We conduct thorough evaluations of each school's performance, celebrating areas that are successful and identifying areas that need further development.

Internal Moderation

We implement internal moderation processes to ensure consistency and high standards in teaching and learning methods, helping to maintain a consistent approach and facilitate the sharing of effective practices.

Time for Curiosity Sessions (T4C)

We host T4C sessions focused on specific topics, to encourage innovative thinking among our staff. These provide opportunities to explore new ideas and approaches that will enhance the educational experience for our learners.

EYES Reviews

The Aspire EYFS Lead works regularly with our Early Years teams to develop their offering. We conduct a termly review at each school to ensure that our youngest learners are receiving a strong foundation for their educational journey.

Pupil Achievement Meetings

Data on pupil achievement is meticulously analysed and discussed with Principals. This helps track pupil progress, identify areas of need and develop strategies to support all pupils to achieve their full potential.
