Our EDEN provision supports children with a range of additional needs, including SEND and SEMH (Social, Emotional and Mental Health) challenges. This role involves working with small groups of children, with a strong focus on helping them become ready to learn while developing their foundational skills in a nurturing, structured environment.

We are looking for a teacher who:

- Has a strong understanding of special educational needs and a commitment to inclusive practice
- Has extremely high expectations of both behaviour and pupil achievement, including for those with complex needs
- Is enthusiastic, hardworking and a strong team player
- Is willing to learn and embody “*The St Gregory’s Way*” – our trauma-informed, restorative approach to supporting children and working collaboratively as a team
- Values the importance of building relationships and creating a classroom where children feel safe, supported and ready to succeed
- Believes that learning should be engaging and enjoyable, and that children thrive when they are challenged, nurtured and inspired
