Apprenticeships







Greenwood Academies Trust regularly employs new apprentices and utilises the Trust's apprenticeship levy fund to upskill our existing staff.

This is accessible to everyone.

We work with training providers who are rated good or outstanding by Ofsted and who deliver

training at your workplace and online, so you won't need to travel to college.

You are assigned a tutor who visits you at work to support your learning and they stay in contact by email and phone.

Most apprenticeships require learners to hold GCSEs at grade C/4 or above in maths and English. Functional skills in maths, English, and ICT can be completed alongside the apprenticeship if required.

Previous qualifications are taken into account and those who already have a degree may still be eligible depending on the subject.

Apprentices need to complete 'off the job training' (OTJT) which develops the learner's skills to support the knowledge, skills, and behaviours for the required apprenticeship.

Examples of OTJT include coaching and mentoring, online learning, shadowing a colleague, and in-house training.
